**Minutes for the Quarterly Meeting held
June 21, 2014**

Karl Frickelton, Chairman, called the meeting to order at 10:07 AM.

A motion was made and seconded to approve the minutes of the Meeting held on March 14, 2014. Motion was approved unanimously.

The Lake Management Report was given by Mike Backus.

Mike attended the 2014 Wisconsin Lakes Partnership Convention in Stevens Point, WI in May. A separate report of the meeting will be posted on the website.

There is a new sign for the boat landing thanks to Dave Hanson. The Landing Sign was updated with the wake hours and the boat traffic pattern. There were two copies made and Mike installed one.

Fish Cribs: The DNR issued a 3 year permit to add 5 more fish cribs to the lake. Trees are weighted and sunk into 20-30 feet of water to provide critical habitat for the fingerlings stocked in the lake by the DNR. Donation/purchase of some 25 Christmas trees is underway for installation of 5 more fish cribs. Mike is waiting on the response from the growers.

Treatment for Eurasian Water Milfoil: The Lake was treated June 3, 2014. Discussion of the lake treatment included raking and hand pulling the weeds by divers, spot treatment with concentrated levels and entire lake application.

Lake Water Level Measurements: The measurement of the water level started April 30, 2014 for this season. In May the level was up 2 inches from the baseline measurement. When measured again, it was back to the baseline measurement. Currently the water measurement in June is up 3 inches since the baseline measurement.

Lake Water Quality: Readings are completed to measure the lake water quality. The water clarity readings were 22-24 feet for the first 3 tests. These were excellent readings. The latest readings were 19 feet and 16 feet.

June chemical test of phosphorus and chlorophyll was performed and mailed in for analysis.

Mike will make sure that Jordan Lake will participate in the world wide Secchi Dip-In June 28-July 20, 2014.

Ice packs will be given to boaters this year at the Clean Boats/Clean Waters Program Landing Blitz July 3rd –6th.

Lake Management Plan: The JLRPD website <http://jlrpd.org/> now has a link to the Adams County Land and Water Conservation Department site with the current updated Lake Management Plan.

Dan Schleiter gave an update on the Treasurer's report.
