Adams County Lake Alliance -no report

Lake Management Report

Mike Backus presented numbers from last year. Some highlights below. Full Lake Management report available on the website.

Full ice on this year was 12/12/2019

Average lake quality disc readings averaged 15 feet.

Clean Boats / Clean Waters interviews reported that 18% of the boats reported they had been in another body of water in the last 5 days. This reinforces the Clean Boats / Clean Waters keeping boaters vigilant about bringing weeds and live well waters to our lake.

Adams County did not remove the public pier last year and it has suffered even more damage. Adams County coordinator for the launch was unaware of any issues but will follow up.

State grant for funding to combat invasive species ended after 9 years. This matching grant money has been key to our keeping weed controls costs to the tax rolls to a minimum. Grant extension has been applied for but won't know the answer for several more months.

General discussion about the state of Fur Drive and the some of the options. Again, the Lake District has no jurisdiction in the matter and the Jackson Township is the authority for Fur Drive.

Discussion about the Drainage District and their involvement. General consensus was that nobody downstream would ever want that volume of water.

Questions about return to wake rules is a Jackson Township decision.
