Clarity:

Best was 22 feet in May / Worst was 13 feet in August.

Temperature since ice off:

Lowest 52 degrees / Highest July 4 at 81 degrees.

Shaw's have celebrated their 10th year maintaining this program. Thanks for your service.

So far there have been 46 sessions with 90 hours recorded.

It was reported that there is an on-going engineering study funded by a private citizen as to options to control lake levels. There are a couple options on the table. This study is very preliminary and the plan is to have more information available at the October Quarterly Meeting.
