Meeting called to order at 12:00.

Approve minutes of the April 3, 2021 Quarterly Meeting. Bob Biancalana made motion to approve. Jeff Steve Fiornetino seconded. Motion carried.

Lake Management Report

Mike Backus presented current lake fact findings current to June 2021. Reports of weed treatment, water temperatures, clarity, and chemical analysis are available on the JLRPD website.

Mark and Laura Shaw reported that they were the only 2 volunteers so far this year. They have conducted 24 sessions and logged 59.5 hours. Their service needs to be commended. They also need help. Their contact info is on the website. They also passed around a signup sheet at the meeting.

The engineering proposal to lower the lake level is still moving forward but very slowly. The board noted that they do not possess the expertise or knowledge in these matters. A law firm specializing in Lake law and has been retained to help answer questions and provide guidance to help get things moving forward.

William Pegler from the Jackson Township board was present at the meeting and stepped forward to field questions. There were many comments and some of the more relevant comments are listed below.

- Why will the township board not consider discussing the no wake situation because of a pending law suit. What does the law suit have to do with wake?
- How can an emergency order remain in effect after nearly 3 years?
- Wind erosion and ice are major shoreline contributors.
- It was noted that a lot of homeowners have put in shoreline remediation efforts in the past year.
- If the township board will not recognize the Lake District board vote to remove wake would the township board recognize the vote if a special meeting was called and the required notices were given.

- Jeff Thomm offered to take the Township Board for a tour of the lake to see the erosion prevention efforts.

Mr. Pegler said he would take the comments back to the township and get back to Jeff Thomm.
